



All Quincy University teacher licensure programs, including our school counselor licensure program, are fully accredited by the Illinois State Board of Education. Quincy University has approved programs in the following areas leading to an educator license:

- Early Childhood Education, Birth – 2<sup>nd</sup> grade
- Elementary Education, 1<sup>st</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup> grade
- Middle Grades Education, 5<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> grade in English – Language Arts, Mathematics, Science, and Social Science
- Secondary Education, 9<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> grade in Biological Sciences, English, Mathematics, and Social Science – History
- Special Education, Kindergarten – 12<sup>th</sup> grade
- School Counselor, PreK – Age 21

Additionally, we have licensure endorsements in Reading Teacher, Bilingual/English as a Second Language, and Special Education. We offer subsequent endorsements in Early Childhood, Elementary, Middle Grades, Secondary, and Special Education.
